Vaccination against flu is recommended for people aged 65 years or older and also for people with any of the following health problems:

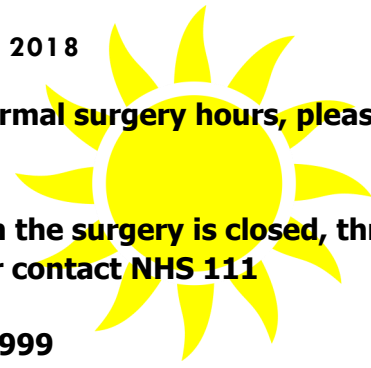

DISPENSARY UPDATE

We are going to be streamlining the running of the Dispensary. Please find below some of the new guidelines when ordering medication from us.

1. Please allow 48 hours for your repeat medication. For example if you order Monday afternoon your medication will be ready Wednesday afternoon.
2. Please can you make a note of your collection date, your medication won't be ready before.
3. Payment—We are happy to take cash or card payments but please note that medication cannot be given without payment or a valid exemption at the time of collection. You may be fined by the Prescription Payment Authority if you make a false declaration.
4. Unfortunately, we are not able to dispense Hospital, Dentist or private prescriptions. These must be collected from the Hospital or a Pharmacy.
5. To enable us to provide an efficient service to all patients, we will no longer dispense medications whilst you wait.

Travel Vaccinations

Please remember to book Travel Vaccinations at least 6-8 weeks before travel as we do not routinely have last minute appointments available and we also need to order in the appropriate medications.



Online Patient Access

A reminder that you can register to use our online patient access system. This enables you to book GP appointments and request repeat prescriptions. For more information, please contact Reception. This service can be useful if you have problems getting through to us on the phone during busy periods.

Centrifuge

The Surgery have recently purchased a centrifuge with money that has been donated to the Golden Valley Patient fund. Currently we are only able to take blood in the morning as the Hospital Courier picks up the samples from us around 11.30am this will now enable us to do 99% of bloods to be taken at any time of the day allowing our patients to have the option to book a more convenient appointment time.
